Peer Support/Recovery Coaching Update- Dave Sanders

- BridgeValley has developed a program which individuals can receive core training, and then move into a practical experience, and help with exam under their workforce development Does Cost \$1900 to go thru the program,
- Currently the Behavioral Health Facilities 2.3 million in direct funding in the Peer Support/Recovery Coach

- There is an AFA for the position is up to each individual employer
- Future- More positions and more competitive
- Specialization Training-32 counties that is served by recovery coaches 17 employers DMAPS-
- STRFA will double the available 38 positions is available
- Training in the STR grant- offenders that are reentering community, pregnant postpartum women, overdose survivors
- Forming a partnership with EMS for nonfatal overdose,, with emergency depts for a nonfatal overdose, First Responders can make referrals to recovery coaches STR is for training, Continuing Education, existing coaches, and future coaches, Meaningful Trainings, Elmira NY, they have a number of turnkey trainings, and train the trainers training.
- Topics- Medication Supported Recovery, ethical practice, essential coaching skills, basic and advanced, training for supervising peers (Georgia uses a dual model) offer a workshop on Recovery capital (any resource that i have that can help me in recovery) Advocacy training 1 day, and Recovery and staying in your lane
- CRAFT- Trains family members in helping get treatment
- What do we have for long term treatment- Could mean changing environments etc

State Targeted Response to the Opioid Crisis (STR) Initiative Overview- Dave Sanders

- Fairly large grant, 2 year \$12 million in packet
- 11 states got that grant, COAT Model- Comprehensive Opioid Addiction Treatment- end goal is abstinence- several things you have to do, show up weekly, must attend therapy groups twice a week, and twice a week recovery meeting, such as AA, NA, pretty intensive, has some great outcomes, replicating that in WV, 4 different locations for that which is also expanding to 8 locations working with pregnant women with opioid use disorder
- Lived experience with addiction for Recovery Coaching- Can Receive Recovery Coaching
- Received a 2nd year- and received supplemental funding and want to expand medicated assisted treatment in rural and non-rural Work with emergency room providers
- Project Engage- Work with emergency Room Providers, EMS etc and MAT Telemedicine
